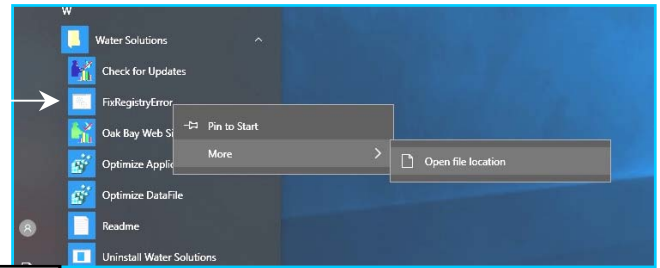
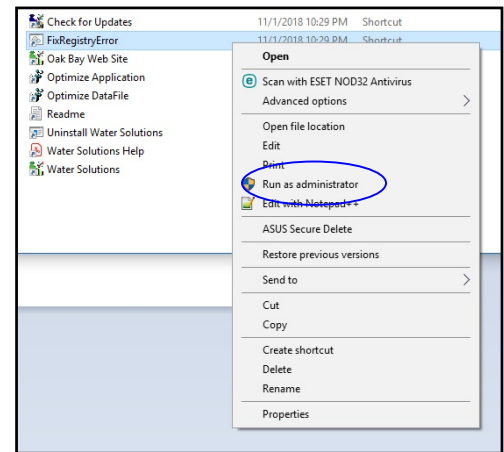
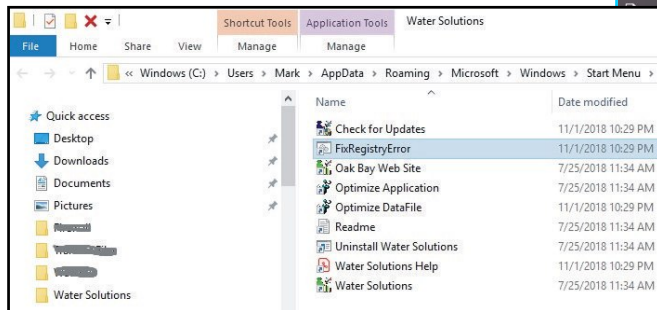


## How to fix the Can't Initialize Registry problem Windows 10

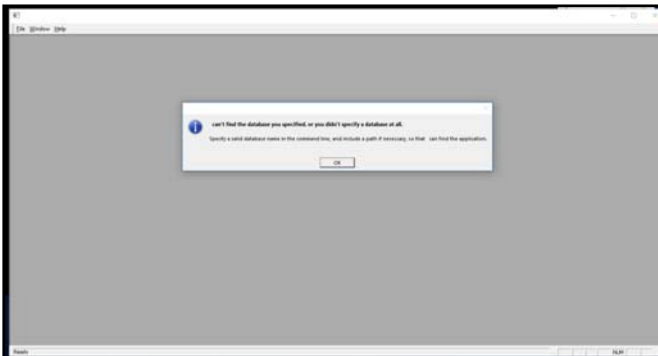
1. Click on the Start Button.
2. Use the scroll bar and scroll down the list of programs until you locate the yellow Water Solutions folder.
3. Open the Water Solutions folder.
4. Right click on Fix Registry Error.
5. Select More.
6. Click on Open File Location.



7. Find the FixRegistryError file and right click on the file name.



8. Click on Run as Administrator.
9. Your computer will ask if you want to allow this program to make changes to your computer. Answer



Yes. In a moment you should see the following window. Ignore the error.

10. Click on okay. The window should close leaving the following window.

Completed Initial Registry Repair. If further repair is required you
will be prompted to complete an additional routine.
Press any key to continue . . .
```

11. Please read the note and press any key. The window should close.
12. Go ahead and start your Water Solutions Program. Your program should start normally.
13. If for some reason during the startup you get an additional notice about the registry values needing to be updated, enter okay.
14. The process should only take a moment to complete and you should be able to start your program.
